The Association, since July 1970, has been classified by the IRS as a 501c (5) tax exempt labor organization [not a union]; however, dues, gifts, or contributions to the Association are not tax deductible as charitable contributions.

From President Bob:

First: Congress is still passing laws so everyone should let their representatives know how and why you support or oppose certain bills that affect federal worker benefits.

H.R. 82 – After LEGCon23 we now have 288 cosponsors for the Social Security Fairness Act of 2023. Two more cosponsors are needed to place this legislation on the House Consensus Calendar. If passed, this legislation would eliminate the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) and Government Pension Offset (GPO). Representative Adam Smith has not cosponsored this legislation; if you live in Congressional District 9, please urge Representative Smith to cosponsor H.R. 82.

Washington State Federation (WSF)

Annual Meeting – the federation will hold its annual meeting virtually again this year on September 27th from 10:00AM to 1:00PM. A Federal Employees Health Benefits rep will explain the new Postal Service Health Benefit (PSHB) plan that will go into effect in 2025. WSF Service Officer Charlie Caughlan will discuss what needs to be done when a spouse passes away, e.g., contacting OPM (annuity and life insurance), TSP and Social Security.
