From President Bob:

Welcome to 2024. As the we start the new year, I want to reflect on the lack of participation at our meetings. Last year we had some great speakers but we can't continue to invite people if only a few people attend. Please email me if you have a speaker that would draw you to a meeting or if you think we should just suspend regular meetings.

As of 5 Feb, we now have 307 Representatives signed on for the H.R.82 and 51 Senators for S 597 the Social Security Fairness Act of 2023. If passed, this legislation would eliminate the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) and Government Pension Offset (GPO). Representatives Kristina Marie Gluesenkamp Pérez and Adam Smith are the only two from our state to not cosponsored this legislation. If you live in Congressional District 3 or 9, please urge them to cosponsor H.R. 82. The good news is Senator Marie Cantwell joined the cosponsors 10/31/2023. The "GovTrack" website still shows a 4% chance of this becoming law. This is frustrating as the votes are there. Note that the

House bill was sponsored by a Republican and Senate bill by a Democrat.

The chapter will sponsor some members to attend the Washington State Federation (WSF) meeting October 24-26 in Kennewick, WA. Let me know if you would like to apply to be a representative.
