. As of Oct., we now have 324 Representatives signed on for the H.R.82 and 63 Senators for S 597 the Social Security Fairness Act of 2023. A discharge petition was signed by the required 218 representatives to force a vote. All of our representative signed the petition except Jayapal, Smith and DelBene. If passed, this legislation would eliminate the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) and Government Pension Offset (GPO).
